



SGLA Technical Training is pleased to continue offering Freeman & Jewell's preparatory courses for candidates taking the **Landscape Architect Registration Examination**. The courses are now **live, online** and open to the entire US and Canada.

Course content is based on the current (2017) exam format and specifications. We will meet in a password-protected Zoom classroom for a mix of lecture, group discussion, and practice tests. Upon registration, every student will receive our substantial course syllabus in pdf format. The class also serves to establish a natural, continuing study network that includes candidates from across the US and Canada.

SECTION 1: PROJECT AND CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT/ SECTION 2: INVENTORY AND ANALYSIS

This intensive two-day course focuses on preparing students to take Sections 1 and 2 of the LARE. The course includes an in-depth overview of the exam and exam-specific test taking tips. The bulk of our time is spent reviewing CLARB's test specification topics and using practice exams to assess candidates' knowledge. The Section 1 and 2 Syllabus contains approximately 310 pages of information and 285 practice questions.

SECTION 3: DESIGN

This three-day course focuses on preparing students to take Section 3: Design. Students will be exposed to the fundamentals of planning and design skills that CLARB considers necessary to pass this section, and we will practice applying problem solving techniques on sample test questions in graphic and multiple response formats. The Section 3 Syllabus contains approximately 370 pages and at least 235 practice test questions. We also include separate packets containing 25 design advanced item type (AIT) problems with solutions, for practice during class and for follow-up study group use.

SECTION 4: GRADING, DRAINAGE AND CONSTRUCTION DOCUMENTATION

This intensive three-day course focuses on preparing students to take Section 4. This course includes a look at material that is typically covered on the exam and strategy tips for analyzing and answering advanced item type questions (AITs). The course will include a short refresher on the fundamentals of grading and drainage. We will focus on building and reinforcing skills essential to successfully completing section 4 of the LARE. The Section 4 Syllabus contains over 515 pages of information, and includes a minimum of 210 test questions and 42 Advanced Item Type problems in separate packets that include the problem and its solution.
